## **Avon Tyrrell Kit List**

Here is a clothing / kit suggestions list in readiness for the trip to Avon Tyrrell in March 2024.

Additionally, we have set up the payment system **on Arbor** so that your additional payments can be added as and when you are in a position to make them.

We have drawn up the following basic kit list as a guide to what your child will need for their stay.

<u>Please note that your child's clothing will get very, very dirty.</u> As a result, we <u>strongly advise</u> that the clothing for this trip is not brand new but rather that it is old and well worn. In previous years some parents have picked up bargains at charity shops / on Vinted (or other such sites).

- Warm clothing for outdoor activities:
  - trousers (ideally shower proof not jeans),
  - o sweatshirts, jumpers, long sleeved tops,
  - o thick socks,
  - o gloves,
  - o hat
- \*\*If the weather forecast is good and we have warm, sunny weather. articles such as warm hats and gloves will not be required; sun hats, sun cream will be required instead\*\*
  - \*\* Shorts and T-Shirts for warmer weather (although long trousers are still required for most activities)\*\*
- Indoor clothing to change into if their outdoor clothes are wet track suit, Tshirt, sweatshirt or jumper.
- Strong, waterproof shoes for outdoor activities, (wellies are not required)
  - trainers for indoor activities.
  - o slippers for the bedrooms.

- Clean underwear/socks for changing daily. (Enough for 5 days so that children have spares)
- A towel, soap, flannel/sponge, shampoo for showers, toothpaste, toothbrush.
- Pyjamas/night-clothes, dressing gown.
- Torch for nocturnal trips to the toilet/activities. (We will be doing a night walk)
- Any medication for staff to administer: asthma pumps, prescribed medication, travel pills. (These must be given to a member of staff on the morning of departure rather than being packed in your child's bag)
- Lip balm.
- Shower cap if required.
- A labelled bin bag to bring home any dirty clothing.
- Anorak or light weight jacket. (Showerproof / Waterproof please). Please DO NOT send your child in a puffer / padded jacket or coat as these soak up rain, become very heavy and uncomfortable for your child to wear)

PLEASE - NO NON-MEDICINAL AEROSOLS (such as hairspray, deodorant spray, body spray) – as these may cause false fire alarms. Roll on deodorant is fine if your child requires it.

PLEASE - NO BAGS OF SWEETS, CHOCOLATE, CRISPS OR SNACKS.

Children will be expected to care for their own property. No other valuables should be taken on this trip e.g. mobile phones or any other form of electronic device.
