New Forest Wildlife Park

The entire Year 4 Team wants to say a huge thank you to all the children for their hard work and amazing effort towards their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) this year.

To reward their efforts, we are excited to offer a trip to the New Forest Wildlife Park!



During the trip, the children will meet many different species of mammals and birds, including wolves, lynx, otters, polecats, ferrets, badgers, pine martens, mink, Scottish wildcats, wild boar, wallabies, and deer.

They will encounter threatened and endangered species and will become aware of issues surrounding environmental changes and pollution, as well as the need for wildlife protection and conservation. In addition, the children will see the trees and plants that grow in the park and discover the importance of forests in maintaining the delicate balance of nature.

To add to the excitement, there is a fantastic adventure playground, which is the ideal place for exploration and fun. Located among the trees and in sight of the park's wildlife, Go Wild! has a zip wire, log jumble, 'birds' nests' climbing ropes, swings, spider nets, and more.



We hope that the children will develop an understanding and respect for the creatures of the countryside while gaining personal benefits from their close contact with nature.
