Tickets

It has long been a tradition at Warren Park for the Year 6 children to perform an end of year show. This year the children will be performing:

This performance will be held at Park Community School Theatre. We are offering tickets at £6.00 each (it is the same price for both parents and children). We will try to accommodate all requests for tickets.

As with previous years, tickets will be issued on a first come first served basis once purchase has been completed through Arbor (see attached instructions). The tickets will then be issued during the school day, by the Year 6 staff, and sent home with the children. There will be no ticket sales through the office this year.

Each ticket will have a number which will be your allocated seat for the performance. The total number of tickets available for the evenings are 222.

We respectfully ask that parents do not record the show in any format as it spoils the experience for those sitting further behind. We are hoping to offer a recording of the show, to be available on our Warren Park YouTube channel.

Rehearsals

Rehearsals for this year's production will take place at Park on Monday 15th July from 9am - 3pm. Weather permitting, we will be walking there and back. Children cannot be collected directly from Park Community School in the afternoon - we apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

For those parents who are not attending the evening shows, the children will need to be collected from the main entrance at Park for 9.00pm prompt.

Only people with a seated ticket will be allowed admission.



Summer Ball

We will be holding The Summer Ball on Thursday 18th July between 6.30 - 9.30 pm. The children will be served mocktails on arrival, followed by a sit down meal and a few speeches. The evening will be rounded off with a bit of dancing. The children have requested that the dress code be formal.

Any cars arriving will be able to turn and drop the children on the top playground where everyone will be able to see them. Gates will open at 6pm for vehicle access. There will be a red carpet for the children to walk up and into the ground floor classroom. We ask that, as the children make their way in, all parents will remain on the grass verge in order to keep everyone safe, and allow the vehicles enough turning space. There will be plenty of time and opportunity for you to take as many photographs of your child as you wish.



The Summer Ball will finish at 9:30pm. We ask that the children are collected promptly from the **main gate**, where they will be escorted to by the staff who have enjoyed the evening with them.

We do hope to see all of our Year Six children there and we look forward to a really magical evening.

As a contribution towards summer events, we are asking for the sum of £20 to help with costs.

This contribution will help us towards the cost of hiring the theatre at Park Community School, who allow us to use their facilities at the reduced rate of £1725 for the three days. Your support will also contribute towards the cost of the set, the props and all of the costumes. In addition to this, contributions will go towards our Summer Ball evening—the finale of the week and opportunity for the children to enjoy a memorable night of dancing, eating and reminiscing!
