

Year One Phonics - Week 3.

Please support your child's learning this week by concentrating on these sounds. Learning the spellings for the taught sounds.

It is also important that children can read these CEW by sight.

This week teaches the oi, ay and oy graphemes and Year 1 common exception words.

oi Grapheme

The digraph oi is virtually never used at the end of English words.

Example words: oil, join, coin, point, soil

ay and oy Grapheme

ay and oy are used for those sounds at the end of words and at the end of syllables.

Example ay words: day, play, say, way, stay

Example oy words: boy, toy, enjoy, annoy
