1. Aims

We believe that wearing school uniform encourages a feeling of pride and sense of belonging to our school and community. Our uniform is designed to be practical, affordable, washable and comfortable.

2. Our school's legal duties under the Equality Act 2010

The [Equality Act 2010](#) prohibits discrimination against an individual based on the protected characteristics, which include age, sex, disability, race, religion or belief, pregnancy and maternity, and gender reassignment.

To avoid discrimination, our school will allow reasonable adaptations to our policy on the grounds of equality. Parents/carers are requested to contact the school office or SENDCo with any request. These will be considered on a case-by-case basis

3. School uniform

Jewellery
