

# World Book Day Costume Ideas

## **Matilda (from "Matilda" by Roald Dahl)**

- Blue dress
- Red ribbon for a headband
- A book as a prop

## **Harry Potter (from "Harry Potter" series by J.K. Rowling)**

- Black robe or a black oversized shirt
- Round glasses
- A stick as a wand
- Draw a lightning bolt scar on the forehead with eyeliner

## **The Cat in the Hat (from "The Cat in the Hat" by Dr. Seuss)**

- Black clothes
- White paper or fabric for the belly
- Red bow tie (can be made from ribbon or fabric)
- A striped hat (can be made from paper or cardboard)

## **Where's Wally (from "Where's Wally?" by Martin Handford)**

- Red and white striped shirt
- Blue jeans
- Red and white hat (can be made from paper or fabric)
- Round glasses

## **Mr. Bump (from "Mr. Men" series by Roger Hargreaves)**

- Blue top and trousers
- Bandages or toilet paper to wrap around the head and body

## **The Very Hungry Caterpillar (from "The Very Hungry Caterpillar" by Eric Carle)**

- Green clothes
- Red hat or headband with antennae (can be made from pipe cleaners and pom-poms)

## **Pippi Longstocking (from "Pippi Longstocking" by Astrid Lindgren)**

- Mismatched socks
- Brightly coloured dress or top and skirt
- Braided hair with wire to make the braids stick out

## **Charlie Bucket (from "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory" by Roald Dahl)**

- Plain clothes (jeans and a t-shirt)
- A golden ticket (can be made from gold paper or foil)

## **Gangsta Granny (from "Gangsta Granny" by David Walliams)**

- Grey wig or hair spray
- Glasses

- Old-fashioned clothes (cardigan, skirt)
- A sack or bag

**Hermione Granger (from "Harry Potter" series by J.K. Rowling)**

- School uniform or black robe
- Wand (stick)
- Book as a prop

**The BFG (from "The BFG" by Roald Dahl)**

- Oversized shirt and trousers
- Belt to tie around the waist
- Big ears (can be made from paper or cardboard)

**Fantastic Mr. Fox (from "Fantastic Mr. Fox" by Roald Dahl)**

- Orange or brown clothes
- Tail (can be made from fabric or paper)
- Fox ears (headband with ears made from paper or felt)

**Alice (from "Alice's Adventures in Wonderland" by Lewis Carroll)**

- Blue dress
- White apron (can be made from a white cloth)
- Headband with a bow

**Peter Pan (from "Peter Pan" by J.M. Barrie)**

- Green shirt and trousers
- Belt
- Green hat (can be made from paper or felt)

**Little Red Riding Hood (from "Little Red Riding Hood" by Brothers Grimm)**

- Red cape or shawl
- Dress
- Basket

**Paddington Bear (from "Paddington Bear" by Michael Bond)**

- Blue coat or duffle coat
- Red hat
- Suitcase or bag
